Be prepared for questions that gauge your motivations, your behaviors, and your technical skill at your level. Interviewers will typically ask open-ended questions, not just “yes” or “no” questions. Maintain a focus on excitement to learn and operate as part of a Team.

You may have a few questions of your own. Don't be afraid to ask them. Showing genuine interest in your potential place of employment conveys interest in the business and your future there.
